POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS MEETING

Dear Parents,

The counselors, teachers and administrators of Buckeye High School would like to share with you some important information about our Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Program (PSEOP) meeting. The Post-Secondary Enrollment Options Program provides opportunities for eligible high school students to enroll in college courses and to receive both high school and college credit. Courses may be taken on a college campus or at Buckeye High School through our Fiber Optic Distance Learning Lab. Establishing eligibility starts by both the parent and the student attending the following meeting:

Attendance of **BOTH** student and parent/guardian is mandatory (by state guidelines) to participate in this program.

Eligibility Requirements:

For 11th and 12th grade participants:

3.30 cumulative GPA with a 24 ACT composite or 1110 SAT composite **OR**

3.5 cumulative GPA (25 on English section of ACT for Honors English class required)

All students must submit an ACT/SAT for placement purposes

For 9th and 10th grade participants:

3.75 cumulative GPA

26 ACT composite or 1150 SAT composite

Letter of recommendation from a school instructor within the field of interest

Grade of at least a B+ in all English courses

Essay of 500 words or less explaining why the student wishes to participate

Ninth and tenth grade students may enroll in only one course per semester

Get high school and college credit simultaneously!
