We are looking forward to a great night. There are new rules regarding the parade and floats this year. Please read them carefully.

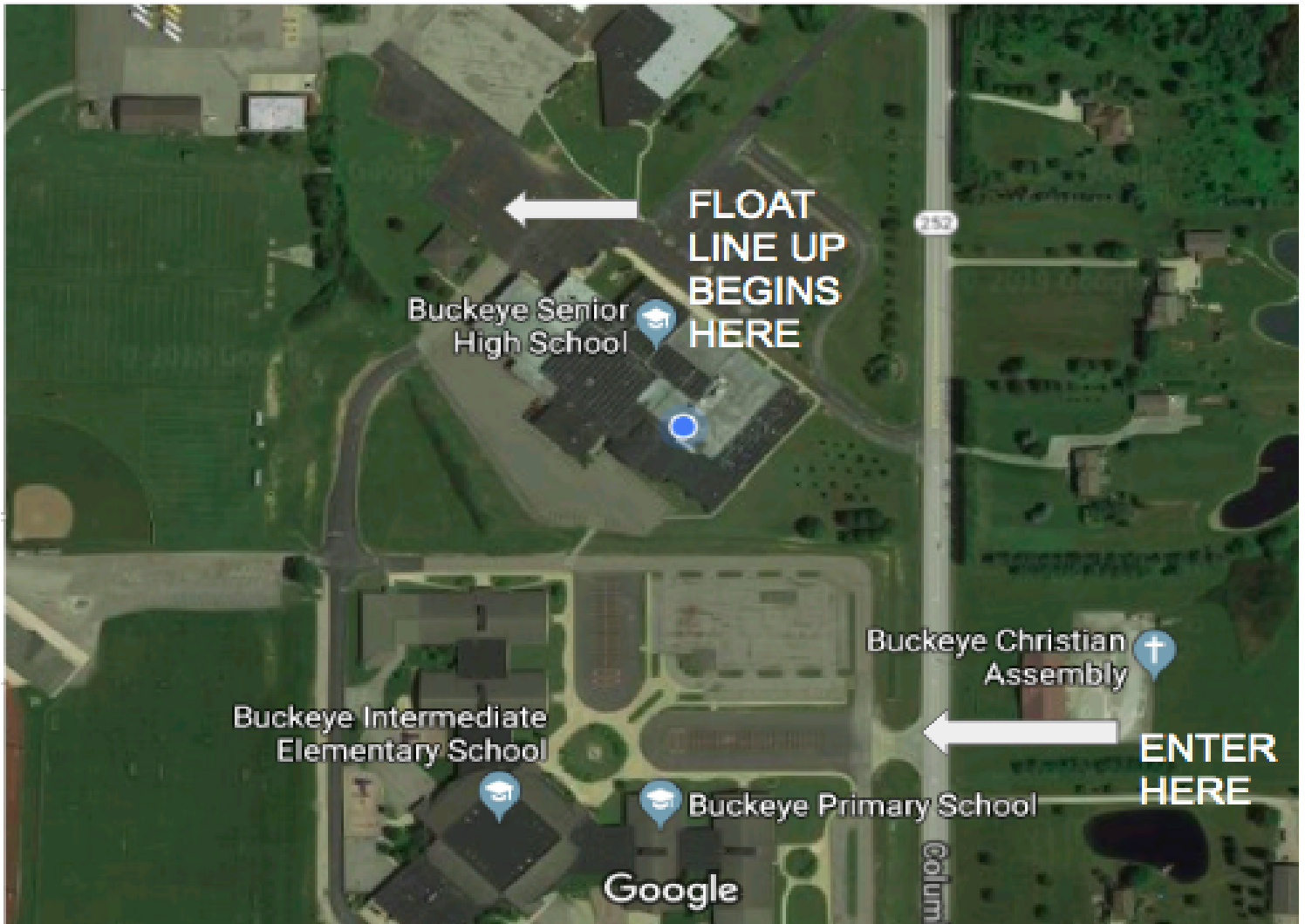
Rules and Regulations:

1. There must be at least one adult on each float, vehicle, or walking group. An email is required for the adult in charge of the group, as he or she will receive the float lineup position.
2. All vehicles must be driven by a responsible adult. Current students are **NOT** permitted to drive in the parade.
3. The trailer must be secured to the hitch.
4. All students riding in the trailer or truck **MUST BE SEATED AT ALL TIMES**, and feet may not dangle or hang off the sides.
5. Students may **NOT** climb on sides or hang on the trailer.
6. Candy must be thrown **UNDER** hand away from the float.
7. The parade consists of **ONE** lap around the track. The band will lead.
8. Groups are expected to line up in the order they are given. Failure to do so will put you at the end of the line-up.

Please see the attached map for instructions on where to enter with floats. We will send an email the week of the parade with your position in the line-up.

- Floats are to enter the elementary parking lot from Rt. 252.
- Line up will begin next to the junior high parking back lot and follow a single file line back towards the elementary building.
- Float line up will be sent via email to the contact responsible the week of the parade.
- Parade starts at 6:00pm. Floats will start being lined-up at 5:15.
